FUNDACIÓN HEBRÓN A.C. FINANCIAL REPORT 2007 & 2008

All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and understood God's grace in all its truth."

God faithfulness to us and his people in Mexico has been amazing. We want to share with you all the great results of your love and offerings to help your brothers and sisters in Tabasco, especially during the flood on November 2007. This offering blessed many lives, communities, families, churches and it keeps giving fruit.

Following is the way the money was used and the families that were benefited. We apologies for the delay of the report, but as you all ready know we were also supporting full time the logistics and official papers work since may 2007 for the Festival of Hope with Franklin Graham – Villahermosa ´08. It was the perfect time after such a difficult time in Tabasco to share the gospel and bring some spiritual help to the people that has lost every thing.

As Fundación Hebrón A.C. we received a -Charitable gift for flood relief- on Tuesday 13th November, totally amount of \$180,063.00 Mexican pesos or £8,100 sterling pounds raised at St Peter´s Farnborough Church in the United Kingdom . A local donor sends \$500 mexican pesos or £22.49 sterling pounds, so we divided the money by categories to be more effective:

- 1. Food 10%**
- 2. 1st need items –personal use cleaning stuff 30%**
- 3. Maintenance and building paint 30%**
- 4. Home and kitchen furnitures 30%**

It was hard to keep track of how many people was directly benefited because in some cases we delivered things the fastest we can to reach more places and families. With the Holy Spirit guide we made decisions with the expenses, because there were always unexpected situations or needs out of control. When the food kits we made were almost ending, our neighbour state "Chiapas", a very poor southern area but also with the largest

Christian and indigenous community in Mexico came with heavy trucks with tons of corn, black beans, sugar, rice, pasta, flour, salt, brooms and maps, clothes, medicines and purified water. Also they were eager to take some people with them to take a break during the intense days of the flood. It was a highlight for us, like a mother receiving help from a daughter because when Fundación Hebrón A.C. started was helping churches in Chiapas building Bible Schools, Hospitals, Camp sites, churches and also sending missionaries.

Now some months later after the flood, we have seen how the cities and houses still recovering. But the alert of another flood is there, especially if we see the rivers and the constantly rain in many states of Mexico. So please keep praying for those all ready affected and wisdom for the authorities to help and allocated people if needed. We will keep you update hoping not to repeat the same story from last November.

Thanks for your quick response and showing love to us, for your prayers and for let us know you were there to help and that we were not alone.

From the bases to the roof it was really damaged, so when we did the food delivery distribution they asked for some help on the reconstruction.

This is a small congregation and during the flood almost all their families were in the shelter and the heavy wind destroyed the roof.
